Reminders on the Projectathon



- Goals of the Projectathon :
 - Test interoperability of systems
 - Test the compliance to specifications
 - Put the specifications to the test
- Event in two phases :
 - Preparatory phase where systems test against simulators
 - Online event: five days long testing event where systems are testing against each other
- Main benefits
 - Fast debugging: you are allowed to fix issues, recompile and retest as many times as needed during the event
 - Cooperation between participants
 - Social Networking

In practice, how does it work?

1. Create an account and register your system

List of the Actors/Profiles you want to test

2. Share your configuration in Gazelle Test Management

Allows other participants to reach out to your system

3. Execute preparatory test cases

 Tests with simulators to improve your confidence in your system and familiarize yourself with the tooling

4. Testing during the event

- The test plan is available in Gazelle TM (tests covering new profiles to come, we'll update you once it is available)
- Test execution (finding a partner, uploading and validating test proofs...) is done through the tools of the Gazelle plateforme
- Tests verification and validation done by monitors during the event

- Send the contract signed by you (email addresses provided in the contract)




Online systems


- You are allowed to let your system available remotely on internet for this testing session under conditions:
 - You must use a Certificate delivered by GSS PKI
 - You must declare all host and endpoint in Gazelle TM configuration
 - You must turn down your firewall (or relax it) to let any other SUT easily test with your system.
 - You must be able to access, debug and re-deploy your system remotely during the pre-test phase AND during the event, just like it should be on your local machine.
 - VPN, SSH, etc...
- Public IPs to access the room in Bern
 - Simulators will have public IPs so they will be accessible from outside the room
 - For other participants (Servers) we are going to do PAT (Port Address Translation) to map their port on the eHealthSuisse public IP




Projectathon Testing Process
